Each Founding Member shall have full voting rights. The dues for senior citizens are ten dollars (\$10) per year (62 years of age or older).

↑ **Active:** Any and all community members of the Greater New Haven community that have an interest in sustaining the African-American heritage in the City of New Haven, who, upon the submission and acceptance of a formal application, and the payment of a yearly membership assessment, elect to fully, and continuously participate in the associations' activities; attend a minimum of six (6) General Meetings in each calendar year; reflects the goals and principles of the association; and does not abuse their oath of office. Each Active Member shall have full voting rights upon payment of dues.

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**ELM CITY FREDDY FIXER PARADE COMMITTEE APPLICANT AGREEMENT:** Eligibility for membership shall be extended to any and all members of the Greater New Haven community that have an interest in sustaining the African-American heritage in the City of New Haven and in the promotion of Ideals of Ecology via Recycling, Neighborhood Beautification, Economic Prosperity and assisting the City of New Haven residents with these aforementioned efforts.

Any person seeking membership must be recommended by three (3) Founding Members in good standing. Upon such recommendation, the Membership Committee (composed of Founding Members) will investigate and interview the candidate and give a written recommendation to the Executive Board of their findings within thirty (30) days of the application submission. An investigation may include a request by the committee for the applicant to give a presentation and autobiography at a regularly scheduled meeting. A sixty percent (60%) vote of the Founding Members shall be necessary to gain membership.

**ELM CITY FREDDY FIXER PARADE COMMITTEE PURPOSE:**

The purpose of the association shall be:

- To finance, organize, and coordinate a parade in honor of the late Dr. Frederick Smith, Edna Carnegie-Baker, and Dr. Charles Twyman, and in celebration of our African-American heritage. The purpose of this year-round grassroots effort is to restore the historical context for which this parade represents: neighborhood beautification through community activism. The Parade will be held on a day to be established each year by the Executive Board at its Annual Meeting.
